

Our Programs

United HomeCare offers a variety of programs, working with a full spectrum of payer sources: Medicare, Medicaid and other state-funded programs, private long-term care insurers, private pay and a unique cost-share program subsidized in part by United HomeCare's charitable fundraising efforts. Our commitment to serve those with limited financial resources goes back more than 35 years when our organization was first founded as a part of United Way.

Private Pay

Our private pay programs include full fee-for-service or cost-share. After an evaluation, United HomeCare will recommend a customized care plan based on the needs of each client. Private pay clients and their caregivers select exactly the services they need. We also accept private insurance programs including long-term care insurances and worker's compensation insurance, among others. Covered services vary depending on the insurer.



Medicare

United HomeCare has been licensed as a Medicare home health agency since 1999 and provides nursing care, specialized physical and occupational therapy, home health aide services, medical social work services, personal assistance with bathing, and much more.

Long-Term Care

Serves clients enrolled in Medicaid and other publicly funded programs providing ongoing, long-term care for home-bound, low-income residents. Our Nursing Home Diversion Program for dually eligible, Medicaid/Medicare clients offers Comprehensive Community Care Services coordinated by a case manager and covers all associated costs with their care.



Miami's First Caregiver Resource Center

In 2010, United HomeCare opened Miami's first Caregiver Resource Center. The center provides long-term care information and links visitors to community assistance programs. It also provides a rich offering of caregiver education classes, support groups, and wellness activities. The services are free to any non-professional caregiver, to help them find solutions to the challenges they face every day.

Working closely with employers, the Center also serves as an information and referral resource for employees with caregiving responsibilities. At the work-site we offer lunch and learn educational workshops and care planning consultations.
