The year 2023 marked a decade of renewal and innovation for United HomeCare® (UHC) on its 50th Anniversary of serving South Florida. In 2020, United HomeCare launched an innovative Learn & Work Program to address a local and national caregiver workforce shortage. Over 200 new Home Health Aides have entered the workforce and are serving our community's older adults.

UHC has also become a designated Alzheimer's Disease Initiative (ADI) Agency for Case Management with funding support to serve both Miami-Dade County and Broward County. We are proud to assist the community as an ADI provider, helping more family caregivers in need of support at home.

Reflecting on over 50 years of dedicated service, United HomeCare is honored to have improved the quality of life for tens of thousands of elderly and disabled individuals in South Florida. Today, we are a leading non-profit home health and community care organization in the State of Florida, and a home care provider for Florida Medicaid Managed, Long Term Care Plans. Our dedicated employees work hard to provide our fellow citizens and neighbors with the high quality of care services they need and deserve to live independently in the comfort of their home.
